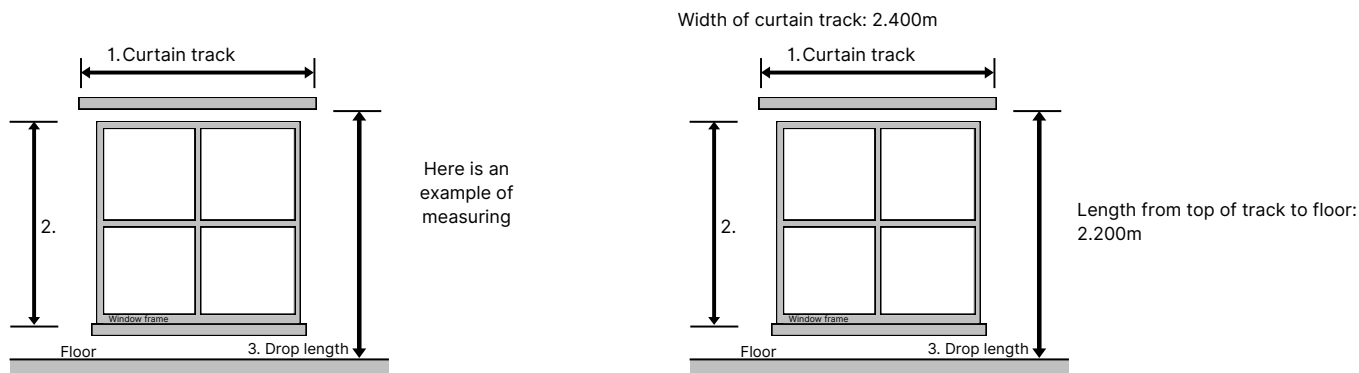

Measuring:

In order to gain and maintain maximum heat retention and insulation in your home, your curtain must start above your window architrave and end at the floor, or on the top of your curtain track to the floor. To measure the width and drop of your curtains is conducted in the same manner.



This example shows that the width of the curtain track is 2.400m and the drop of the curtain would be 2.000m. If you do not have an existing curtain track, then measure the width of the top window panel or architrave end and add 300mm to each end to allow for gathering when curtain is drawn open.
